Sublette County Historic Preservation Board (CLG) 2015 Major Accomplishments

Homesteads – Since 2005, the Preservation Board has conducted a project to document all of the remaining homestead structures in Sublette County. This requires methodically researching every patents record, contacting current owners, and documenting on the ground any remaining structures/buildings. Thanks to the work of Helena Linn work continued in 2015. Approximately 75% of the county has now been covered including documentation of over 500 structures.

Craig Cabin National Register Nomination – Thanks to the work of Ann Noble, the Craig Cabin National Register nomination was completed in 2015 and approved by the state review Board. The nomination is now at the registrar pending final listing.

Preservation Signs – Aided by a CLG grant, the board completed five interpretive/preservation signs at National Register sites. Signs were installed at the Sommers Homestead Living History Museum interpreting the Green River Bridge, a pre-historic medicine wheel, and the Green River Drift cattle trail. Two other signs interpreting the Green River Drift will be installed at the sorting grounds at Trapper's Point and the entrance to the forest at the Bridger-Teton National Forest parking Lot.

CPI Conference – Thanks to a CLG grant, board member Dave Vlcek attended the Colorado Preservation, Inc conference in February. Upon return, Dave provided ongoing training to the Preservation Board, Green River Valley Museum, and Sublette County Board of Cooperative Education Services (BOCES).

National Register Plaques – After reviewing the 19 National Register sites in Sublette County, the Board acquired NR plaques for four of the site which did not have them and presented to the owners. The plaques were placed at the Jensen Ranch, Circle Ranch, Daniel School House, and New Fork Townsite.

Deadline Fire Lookout – In cooperation with US Forest Service, the Board began restoration of the Deadline Fire Lookout building. The windows and doors were removed, building painted, roof repaired, and then boarded up for the winter. Over the winter, windows will be restored, door will be restored and replica shutters will be built to be installed in 2016.

Fort Bonneville – Aided State Parks in developing a Management Plan for the Fort Bonneville historic site. The Board is operating as site stewards. With regular inspections and a camera were able to document unauthorized metal detecting and digging at the site. State Parks is working to install regulation and warning signs at the site in 2016.

4. Project Updates:

a. Craig Cabin:

MOTION: Dave Vlcek moves we support Ann Noble's effort to nominate Craig Cabin to the National Register. 2nd by Jonita. Unanimous

Clint wrote a letter of support. CLG Board members went to visit the site in person. Dawn gave Jill Maier a CD of all the pictures taken from that site visit. Ann's draft report is at the State and is on schedule for their February meeting. We will owe Ann another \$2,000 when that is done and she submits a voucher.

- b. Green River Drift road signs: We have them back now. Bridger-Teton Nat. Forest hasn't finalized location for the Upper Green part, but will find a spot. Sublette County Historical Society wants to replace their sign on top of Trappers Point. Clint will work with them to put together a sign plan for that historic site location. Cost for fiberglass 10'x5' sign would be about \$2,500, also needs a backing, might total \$3,000. Narratives need updating and with new sign technology we can add graphics. Additional signs probably \$2,500 each. Sign design and installation would be donated. Dave Vlcek would donate archaeology work. We also have 2 National Register plaques to work into this sign plan, as well as roadside directional signs.
- c. <u>National Register plaques</u>: These 4 plaques will be back sometime in December (Circle Ranch, Jensen Ranch, New Fork Town site, Daniel Schoolhouse). We will do a press release about them when give out. What about Boulder Community Center, eligible for a plaque? Dave VIcek will go out and look it over. They just went through a significant remodel. Jonita has some history on it and will find it.
- d. <u>Fort Bonneville:</u> Dave Vlcek: Finally got info back from Todd Tebedow with draft of a plan. Has goals, objectives, radio carbon dating, metal detection, collections management, recommended partners, signage, site fence repair, walking path, more. Dave will send it out to members for review.
- e. **Beaver Slide:** No report (Bob not present).
- f. <u>Fire Lookouts:</u> Dave Vlcek: Dave got a response back from USFS archaeologist Jamie Scheon saying he/they would support a project for the lookout. Wants us to come up with a plan. Our next meeting can be a work session to come up with ideas. Bring pictures we took of it and rough out a plan for things we can go up and do next summer. Jamie will talk with FS communications people and see what can be taken off the lookout.

g. **Boulder School:** Jonita has some history on the school and will find it. Dave can go down and check it out.

5. New Business:

- a. <u>Preserve Wyoming conference:</u> Was held Sept 11-13 in Powell, WY. WAPA meeting in conjunction. Dave went, gave us a report today. Their next meeting with be June 11-14, 2015. Maybe we can put together a PowerPoint presentation of our projects and present?
- b. <u>Green River Drift fence</u>: Clint: JIO wanted to propose tearing out old fence and putting up a new wildlife friendly one. Concern is old WWI wire in section of south fence, as well as very old sagebrush growing up in it. Cattlemen use the sagebrush as a blind as part of their sorting during Drift. A meeting was held to discuss it and compromise made that some sections with old wire but don't have historic significance can be replaced.

Clint wants to write a report on the historic significance of the fence to put on file with the JIO so is on the record. Dave has the archaeology for the whole area to add in. Some of that old barb wire is supposedly at the BLM wareyard. Trying to find verification of wire acquisition. Relying on verbal accounts. Clint checked old Pinedale Roundup newspapers looking for ads. Jonita doesn't remember anything in Green River Cattle Assn meeting minutes about where the wire came from.

____Can ask BLM archaeologist Sam Drucker if he can get a sample to compare and have an analysis done on it.

- 3. <u>Craig Cabin Nomination update:</u> Ann Noble: As of yesterday (Monday, April 6th) nomination was in to National. Has 45 days to make a decision. Accepted ones are posted on their website (mid-May). Ann pleased with process.
- 4. <u>History Day:</u> Our Best of Show award went to a girl from Jackson this year, \$200 award. Discussion about how to get Sublette County kids to do better. More support from schools and teachers for program. No Big Piney/Marbleton kids entered this year. Ask schools and coaches how to get History Day more of a priority and how we can help them. Put together a volunteer base to help with program. Have historical boards get together and write a joint letter of support for the program.
- 5. <u>National Register Plaques:</u> Bob gave out plaque at the Cattlemen Association. Still have Daniel Schoolhouse plaque waiting to go out. They know about it. New Fork Park nomination.
- 6. <u>Daniel Fish Hatchery 100th Anniversary:</u> Date a bit uncertain, sometime between 2017-2020. Legislation passed in 1917. Greg Anderson is researching the topic and asked for any help. Ann Noble referred him to Kemmerer Court for info research. Carmel suggested Charlie Raper might also have some info.
- 7. <u>Green River Drift Road Signs:</u> We need to get final locations for signs. Clint will see if he can get on Sublette County Historical Society agenda to see where to put sign at Trappers Point.
- 8. Green River Drift Fence: Clint will write a history and importance of that site. Also will get a sample of the old barb wire fence and find to an expert to send it for analysis to verify it is WWI wire. Purpose is to get back-up of the oral history to defend why the old wire should stay there. Fence supposedly went in 1920 and was surplus military WWI wire. Nothing written down to verify that. Location of old wire has been documented, sagebrush creating a natural fence, distinctive growth pattern, cattle usage are important points of that area.
- 9. <u>Fort Bonneville:</u> This summer will get someone to put out big rocks to block off vehicle traffic on the short road to the rock monument. Will put in a traffic counter at entry. Clint installed a time-lapse wildlife cam on fence taking pictures since January, takes a picture every 5 minutes. Goal is to monitor visitation this year.
- 10. <u>Marbleton Beaver Slide:</u> Bob Beiermann: WYDOT has given permission to put it on that property, however land ownership still not resolved. Small private property inholding owned by someone in California (Lisa Remble Kennedy, Lakeside, California). Town of Marbleton owns rest of the property. Town attorney has tried to contact land owner twice, but no response-they are still paying their property taxes. We may want to think about pursuing this project on an alternate site. Perhaps we could contact owner to see if we can get a long-term lease to put it up?

MOTION: Bob Beiermann move our Board write a letter to the landowner asking for permission to put up the beaver slide.

2nd: Carmel Kail

Discussion: Clint willing to draft the letter. Bob Beiermann and Scott Scherbel help with it. Copy to the Town of Marbleton. Note that we want to put it on cement pillars. Take pictures, aerial photos & show where we want to put it.

No final vote taken.

- 11. <u>Wyoming Cultural Trust Fund:</u> Will meet in Pinedale on May 6th & 7th. Invite for anyone on the Board who might want to go and meet them. They have \$500,000/year they give out. They have given grants for archaeology at the New Fork Park two years and funded the four fiberglass livestock animals at the Sommers Homestead Living History Museum.
- 12. <u>Preserve Wyoming Conference:</u> June 10-13 in Laramie. Ann: If Cora Post Office nomination ready, she can present at that time. If anyone from CLG board wants to go, travel and lodging expenses can be paid. Clint will go.
- 13. Cora Post Office: Ann Noble: Feasibility of doing nomination. Last living person who knows it well is Dick Noble. She interviewed him and toured Cora location with him. He gave her a lot of the history. Sublette County Artist's Guild wrote about it in the 60s & 70s. Original town of Cora built by James Noble. Homesteaded in 1896 by Ann's husband's great grandfather. Cora was on the east side of the New Fork River in 1890s. Old 2-track road went up the east side of the river from Pinedale to Ehman Lane. Original Cora store supplied the tie hacks. Later store, bunkhouse, several other buildings moved up closer to present road which was built in the 1920s to move road to higher ground out of floodplain. Several buildings from old town still down at the Noble property. All buildings and additions more than 50 years old. The Cora Community Hall was donated to Town of Pinedale as first medical center - now is the Pinedale SAFV house. Possible Cora Historic District? Two separate designations: pre-1920s original town site, post-1920s current town site. Ann proposes we go forward with a district at current newer Cora town site and just document the older site. Complication is site privately owned and would set a precedent on how our public board handles (and pays for) private property nominations. Owner is Joanne Ludwig, who wants to sell the property and retire. First Postmaster was a woman named Cora House. Government may cut funding for this small rural Cora Post Office and close it. The old schoolhouse there has been a rental property, now empty. Original teacherage still in good shape, is a rental property, old enough to qualify for nomination, hand-hewn logs built by tie hacks, new roof. Original blacksmith shop in good shape, original roof, mint condition, beautiful log workmanship, antiques inside. Old Abner Lumen homestead from 1880s now on Nelson property. Old bunkhouse, Eddie Edwards tie hack, on a cement foundation now, used for storage, original old cook stove. Original Cora Post Office housing side addition added by Keith Anderson in 50s/60s, would qualify now. Post Office building used to be a bar. Still has original bar and bar stools. Tie hacks used to stop by and drink. Storage buildings, livery stable, lean to, old electric line still exist. Ann's sister-in-law Charlotte did the Cora Post Office sign. Ann also did an oral history of Dick Noble during their tour. Discussion about possibly hiring Ann to do this as part of the Homestead project instead of a full-blown NR nomination.

<u>MOTION</u>: Bob Beiermann move to hire Ann to do Town of Cora as part of our Homestead research project and pay her for research already done. This is for 3 homesteads, Noble, Luman, Westfall. 2nd by Carmel Kail.

Unanimous.

MOTION: By Paul Scherbel. Move we encourage property owner at her expense to add Cora Store to National Register.

No 2nd.

Discussion: Ann said the National Register nomination probably won't happen if Joanne has to pay for the cost all herself. We don't have money in our budget this year to do this nomination. Will be more expensive than the Jack Creek nomination we just did. Ann is the obvious choice to do it because of her family knowledge and contacts. We don't have a legal obligation to do a request for proposals (RFP). Asked Ann to come back with a budget proposal. If we choose not to do this nomination, we should

- give owner info about our belief this could be a successful nomination. Defer further discussion until next meeting when Jonita and Dave can be here.
- 14. <u>Deadline Fire Lookout:</u> Carmel & Bob: Not a lot of info available on BTNF lookout towers. Dianne Boroff's rlative was a lookout there. LW Roberts built the lookout on Prospect Peak. Blueprints for lookout are in Jackson. Only 1 USFS lookout for rent in Wyoming, in Laramie. Wyoming Radio broadband wants to put a repeater at the lookout on Monument Ridge (Hoback Canyon). Bridger-Teton NF has an Osbourne firefinder in the Jackson Ranger District storage building. Could "loan" it to the Green River Valley Museum for a display. Challis Forest "has a lot of them." Carmel located a Teton Forest Radio and Telephone Map (1945) showing phone lines. Telephone lines in rural locations allowed portable phones to clip on connect to line on either a pole or a tree. Darwin Ranch in Tipi Creek has a Forest Service pole that had a telephone on it in the 40s & 50s. Milk cans were used to deliver food to lookouts (cans possibly from earlier area fish stocking program). Castle Fire lookout (1941 two lookouts built), Bald Mtn on North Piney Bird Brothers Sawmill and Red Castles on Bare Pass at the head of Red Castle Creek. Bob will talk with his relative Dan Budd to see if he might know more about area lookout towers.
