Sublette County Historic Preservation Board (CLG) 2021 Major Accomplishments

Projects & Restoration

- Big Piney & Marbleton Building Survey Surveyed 50 historic properties in Big Piney and Marbleton identifying 13 eligible for the National Register. Project will be the basis for future survey, National Register projects, and educational programs.
- Bondurant Dipping Vat Restored a unique and historic cattle dipping vat on Jack Creek in Bondurant, originally built in 1936. An interpretive sign will be installed in 2022.
- Deadline Ridge Fire Lookout Provided routine maintenance including opening for the summer, closing for the winter, and repainting roof & windows. Also, maintain a visitor log.

Consultation & Comment

- Aspen Ridge supported BLM contracted survey of the Aspen Ridge rock alignment site.
- Irrigation PA participated in the creation of state Irrigation programmatic agreement.
- Merna X-over Pipeline reviewed and provided comments to BLM on pipeline effects on Lander Trail.

Site Surveys & Evaluations

- Olson Fire Pits Conducted site survey near fire pits along New Fork River adjacent to the Lander Trail - New Fork River Crossing - Historical Park. Also obtain radio carbon dates for the three previously excavated fire pits.
- Graves Visited and documented condition of Parkinson (private) and Mack (BLM) graveyards. Will install new markers and repair/build fences in 2022.
- Big Sandy Lodge Collected and scanned historical materials to support a future NR nomination. Find contractor in 2022 to begin nomination.
- Big Sandy Reservoir Enlargement Helped Bureau of Recreation with site survey.

Education

 Wardell Buffalo Trap – Sponsored an in person group presentation via zoom from WAPA on the recent site survey of the Wardell Buffalo Trap.

- Minutes of September 22, 2020 regular board meeting.
 MOTION by Dave Vlcek to accept minutes as written. 2nd by Don Schooley. Unanimous, passes
- 2. Big Piney/Marbleton grant: Board members are working on contacts
- 3. **Lookouts:** Bob: weather stripping worked good on Deadline LO. Poster was put inside. Some more visitors signed the guestbook. Roadwork has apparently been done to Monument Ridge LO. We want to talk with the Big Piney District Ranger about Monument LO, Prospect Peak LO and the Bondurant dipping vat.
- 4. **Buckskin Grave Markers:** Don got grave marker put in a couple of weeks ago. He commented that the public can go visit grave markers on private land, by state statute. Mack cemetery Don doesn't know who is responsible for caretaking that cemetery. Clint and Dawn will talk with Cat Urbigkit about it.
- 5. **Aspen Ridge:** Dave: A crew was up there last week, Dave helped them two days. They have access to the drone data and are writing a report now. Will talk with BLM to see if we can get an update on the drone report. Dave commends the BLM for getting more work done on Aspen Ridge and Wardell sites.
- 6. **New Fork Park hearth:** Dave said three samples were taken on three hearths. Cost is about \$1,000 to do analysis. Maybe split cost between us, WAS and Sublette County Historical Society?
- 7. Bondurant Dipping Vat: We want to talk with the Big Piney District Ranger about it
- 8. **Sublette Centennial:** Clint said the Centennial committee is meeting regularly, encouraging people and organizations to be a part. Doing a lot of outreach. About 100 organizations are being contacted. Kick-off event Saturday, February 20th at the Sublette County Fairgrounds. Jonita commented the Green River Valley Museum has a flyer with her grandfather pushing to have Daniel be the county seat in with the Sommers papers. Dave asked who is the oldest living resident of Sublette County? There will be a 2nd event in the summer, but date not set yet. Clint will send a list of the organizations being contacted to the board members. Tim Thompson is working on a commemorative historic barn calendar. Tim will send the barn list to Jonita.

9. Project Updates:

- a) **Big Sandy Lodge:** There still is a little bit of scanning to do.
- b) **Trappers Point Access Road:** Dave: The hearth is not 6000 years old-more recent. The road did not impact the big 6,000 year old antelope kill site. Once report is done and submitted, Dave will submit an invoice to Rio Verde for radiocarbon dating.
- c) **Pinedale Skeletons:** Dave: Someone at the University of Oklahoma lab willing to try to do DNA on all the skeletons. Cost is \$8,000. Haven't heard from other labs. COVID has shut down a lot of places.

- d) Irrigation PA: Dave: Final draft is close, 1 more meeting. Dave will get the draft to the board. He will send to Jonita so she can get to cattlemen.
- e) **New Fork Cattle Bridge:** Dave got permission from landowner Mike Olsen to go look at the bridge
- f) Fort Bonneville: Clint is asking, but no more info on it yet.
- g) Homestead records: Will try to get more scanned this fall.
- h) Sam Drucker projects: Good progress on Wardell and Aspen Ridge. Dave will see if more about Holden Hill.

Meeting called to order at 3:00PM by President Clint Gilchrist

1. **REVIEW MINUTES** – of November 24, 2020 meeting (there was no meeting in December 2020).

MOTION: By Dave Vlcek to accept minutes as presented. 2nd by Carmel Kail. Unanimous, motion passes.

- 2. **BOARD MEMBERS** Carmel was reappointed to the board in January by the Sublette County Commissioners for another 3-year term
- 3. **BIG PINEY/MARBLETON HISTORIC BUILDINGS SURVEY GRANT** Special guest (via Zoom), Rin Kasckow. They have 40 Yes's now for permission from private property owners to inspect their property. Rin thanked the board for the opportunity to do this project. They are collecting research now. They still have a travel ban in their organization due to COVID-19 health restrictions. Looking for more site forms. Carmel sent her a starter file with some site forms. Clint will look to see if there are any more at the Museum of the Mountain Man archives. The Sublette County website has more ownership information on properties. She will do a monthly check-in with the board.
- 4. **HISTORIC REVITALIZATION GRANT** Wyoming SHPO grant opportunity. Deadline is March 1st. Carmel suggested Big Piney Town Hall for window replacements? Owner must be willing to put the building on the National Register. Old windows were half moon, marble glass on top, green and white. Were taken out some time ago. There are some black and white pictures of the old windows. One still exists with a local resident. Site form is 30 years old. Carmel will talk with SHPO about eligibility and get a more recent bid on the windows. Bob will talk with Big Piney Town Council about if they are ok with listing. Rin said she could do nomination as part of BP/M Historic Building Survey. The grant has \$350,000.
- 5. **NEW FORK CATTLE BRIDGE** Jonah Interagency is looking to close down and they have a chunk of money still to spend. Looking for projects. It was suggested possibility to restore this old bridge and make usable, see if National Register eligible? It is quite deteriorated and has been modified. Dave doubts it is eligible as currently is. It is a contributing element for The Drift as a listed property. Pilings need to be redone. Clint talked with Jeannie Lockwood and she would like to see it redone so they can use it again. Daughter Hailey Lockwood is writing a history of the old cattle

- bridge. Other suggestions of possible projects: Green River ferries on Bill Barney's ranch. Republish the Jonah Archaeology brochure.
- 6. **NEW FORK PARK** Clint said he got a phone call from the Game & Fish expressing interest in potentially doing some work at the park for fisheries/wildlife. Even suggested possibly rebuilding the island, bank stabilization. Exploring ideas. They have some \$.

7. PROJECT UPDATES

- **a.** Lookouts Pinedale Lumber has some shingles, cost around \$1000-\$1500 to redo the roof on Monument Lookout. Sawn cedar shingles. Could be for Monument or Prospect Peak lookouts. Bob talked with Big Piney Forest Service Ranger and he is interested. They put some new culverts in road to get to Monument LO, but the road still needs more work to have good access.
- **b.** Bondurant Dipping Vat Looking to get a Letter of Support from Jeannie Lockwood representing the Green River Valley Cattlemen for this project
- **c. Pinedale Skeletons** Dave has sent out some emails inquiring about DNA studies. He hasn't heard back from Rick Weathermon yet about tooth studies. Universities still have people out due to COVID-19. Microwear would cost around \$700. Isotope \$500, DNA \$8000. Maybe Wyoming Cultural Trust Fund would fund DNA study?
- **d. Graves** Still not sure what to do regarding Mack Cemetery. It is on private land. Up to the landowner to do something. Cat Urbigkit has this leased. Need to come up with a plan. Is the Museum Board interested in this as a project? Our board wants to go out and look at it again after snow melts. There are 3 graves. Two have good stones. 1 has a metal brass plate in cement. Clint will ask Museum Board about it. Other cemetery, Kendall Cemetery, is on National Forest managed by Forest Service.
- **e. New Fork Park Hearth Radio Carbon Dates** Dave sent the samples off for all 3 hearths found along the New Fork River last year. Sites will likely be damaged during this spring runoff. Will be several months before we get an answer back. We could do more analysis later.
- f. Big Sandy Lodge Records are all scanned now
- **g.** Irrigation Programmatic Agreement (PA) Dave said there is a new final of the document going around for signatures. It is for larger irrigation projects involving Federal money. Dave said he thought it was a good PA.
- **h. Fort Bonneville** Nothing new to report. COVID-19, new babies, no progress yet. We still have hopes it will get done ultimately. Clint said Dan Bach will try to get some movement going on it again on the inside.
- i. Homestead Record Scanning Planning another scan day, February 6th at Office Outlet, 9AM. Dave, Don, Carmel, Andrea, Clint, Dawn. 2 drawers left to scan.
- **j. Sam Drucker Projects** Nothing new to report. Information will be available when comes out on WyoTrack.

- Review & approve minutes of January 26, 2021 regular board meeting
 MOTION: By Dave Vicek to accept minutes as presented. 2nd by Don Schooley. Unanimous, motion passes.
- 2. **Big Piney/Marbleton Grant:** We have 43 yeses back now. We have contacted the ones we know. The ones left none of us know personally. The contractors will give an update next month. We have a good set of properties to start with for the survey.
- 3. **Historic Revitalization Grant:** Considering what project we might be able to do. Can't do Big Piney Town Hall because it isn't a commercial building. Daniel Schoolhouse is pursuing their own grant options. We don't have another project in mind. We will wait until the Big Piney/Marbleton survey is done and Centennial and see if Big Piney Town Council more excited about replacing the windows.
- 4. **JIO Grant:** We gave them ideas for several possible projects. Jonah booklet would cost about \$3,000 to reprint. 1.9 miles of fencing at New Fork Park about \$25,000 to make wildlife friendly. Bathroom at New Fork Park about \$25,000-\$30,000. The JIO Evaluation Team is finalizing their project recommendations. Their board meets in May.
- 5. **Sublette Centennial:** The County has a Proclamation and Centennial Committee put together Fun Facts. Launched Feb. 15th with press releases, signs, banners and ribbons around the county. Encouraging people in the county to participate. They would like to do a big event this year, maybe in conjunction with Sublette County Fair. The Sublette County Historical Society and Green River Valley Museum got a grant to hire historian Ann Noble to help organizations and businesses to research their histories. Would like to do something with Centennial businesses, have Chamber help. Brand local events as Centennial events. Have Centennial products, t-shirts, coffee, Centennial quilt, etc.
- 6. **Wardell Buffalo Trap Presentation:** February 26th by Zoom, Museum of the Mountain Man will put up on their big screen. Program a presentation of WAPA Wyoming Association of Professional Archaeologists, update on survey work done summer 2020.

7. Project updates:

a) **Lookouts:** Bob will see about getting the Big Piney District Ranger up to Monument and Deadline lookouts sometime. Want to get some work done on Monument LO, but need USFS permission, roof, windows, foundation stabilization. Similar to Deadline LO.

MOTION: By Dave to let Bob get a bundle of sawn cedar shingles from Pinedale Lumber for up

- to \$100. 2nd by Don Schooley. Unanimous, motion passes
- b) Bondurant Dipping Vat: Clint will try to connect with Johnny regarding rebuilding it.
- c) **Pinedale Skeletons:** Dave reported nothing back yet. Dave will ask Rick Weathermon if anything has been written up on it-how the people died. \$8000 for DNA on teeth.
- d) Graves: Will check on Mack Cemetery in spring once snow melts.
- e) New Fork Park Hearth: Radio carbon dates will take 6-8 weeks. Cost about \$860 for the 3 samples to be tested. We want to go record the surface of the site in the spring.

Meeting called to order at 3:05PM by President Clint Gilchrist.

- Review minutes of February 23, 2021 regular board meeting
 <u>MOTION</u> by Dave Vleck to accept minutes as present. 2nd by Carmel. Unanimous, passes.
- 2. Big Piney/Marbleton Survey (this agenda item delayed until Ren could join meeting via Zoom)
- 3. Olsen site Radio Carbon Dates: Dave Vlcek reported he got date results back. Three readings:. 1: 924BP +- 20 years; 2: 1153 BP +- 20 years; 3: 4050 BP, +- 24 years (this was the very deep feature) Invoice for testing was \$877.00. Clint proposes we pay 1/3, the Historical Society pay 1/3, and WAS pay 1/3.

MOTION by Carmel for our CLG board to reimburse Dave Vlcek \$293.00 out of Preservation Board budget for Olsen site testing. 2nd by Andrea. All aye except Dave abstain. Motion passes.

Dave still has more dirt from deep feature if we want testing for macrofloral (cost about \$100).

MOTION by Carmel that we do macrofloral testing. 2nd by Bob Beiermann. Unanimous, passes.

Dave will send to Dan Bach. Dave would like to tell Mike Olsen the radio carbon date results.

3:11PM: Rin joins meeting via Zoom. Clint will give Dave Mike's phone number. Dave suggests putting up an interpretive sign by the conical pole lodge at New Fork Park (currently no sign there). Dave said 1500-1000BP was a surge in Wyoming area for occupation. Clint suggested this would be a good project to pull together data for interpretation. Carmel & Dave will look into it (dates on SHPO). Write up Pinedale skeletons, New Fork Park, Wardell, public info on population explosion and what life was like 1,000 years ago in the Upper Green River Valley and Wyoming.

- 4. **Big Piney/Marbleton Survey** Carmel reported not too much has changed. We do have a couple more landowner 'yes-es'. 46 Yes out of 52/53 contacted, 4 Nos, 7 no response. Will not do a site visit or fill out a form on the No's. Discussion about looking at some of the 1940 buildings to get more data. Jonita will flag names of people on the list who have family ties to the buildings and might know more info. Our contract is short about 7 buildings. Bob will think if there might be more we could do. Rin reported they are working on requesting site numbers, filling in site forms, doing some background historical research. Week of May 1st they will come and take some photos. Others will come May 17-June 6 to do more research. Pinedale Library has microfilm of Big Piney paper. Green River Valley Museum research library may have more info. Other resource books: Tales of Big Piney, Herman's Howlings, Sally Freidrickson book, Nebaker book. Clint will put together a list of books that might be helpful to them.
- 5. **JIO Grant** Jonah booklet, New Fork Park: These are projects of the Sublette County Historical Society. The JIO board will meet later this month (April 22nd) to decide about grants for the bathroom at New Fork Park, fencing, reprinting Jonah brochure. We will take this topic off our CLG agenda list.
- 6. New Fork Cattle Bridge site form: CLG (Vlcek & Carmel) had planned to record this bridge on a site form this year. However, JIO will be meeting in May and possibly fund restoration work on the bridge. Any restoration work would have to go through SHPO, and their recordation requirements might be more than simple site form. Defer this topic off our CLG agenda until after JIO acts. The bridge is in poor shape. The last time cattle were driven across it was 2014 or 2015.
- 7. **FY 2022 Budget:** Will discuss more in depth at our next board meeting. Don't have instructions **y**et from County on budget request reductions. Rumor is a 50% cut. Clint asked Board members to think of ideas for projects and bring to our next meeting.
- 8. **Seismic Museum** Randy Stamey: Carmel said Randy would like to start a seismic museum in Pinedale. He has a lot of things. Possible speaker?

9. Project updates

- a) Lookouts (Monument, Deadline, Prospect)
- **MOTION** by Dave to reimburse Bob Beiermann \$116.43 for lookout shingles. 2nd by Don. Unanimous, passes. A new roof on Prospect LO will cost about \$1000. Bob will try to get up to Deadline LO sometime soon to check it out.
- b) **Sublette County Centennial** The Centennial committee is working with a lot of local groups to gather centennial history. The Sublette County Historical Society got a grant to hire historian Ann Noble to help with some historical research and compilation. Clint will email a contact list of these groups to our board members. Encouraging people to do events and create products related to the centennial. The Centennial Committee is doing a barn calendar.

- c) **Homestead Records:** Don, Carmel, Dave, Clint & Dawn finished scanning the last of the homestead records. Ultimately the files will be taken down to the Green River Valley Museum.

- 3. **Bondurant Dipping Vat:** Reconstruction work turned out great. Needs a fence around site to keep cattle out. Clint will talk with Johnny Petersheim about his recommendations. We don't have the final bill yet, hopefully will be enough left over for the perimeter fence. We need to get with Forest Service about an interpretive sign (Carmel & Dawn).
- 4. **Graves Mack & Parkinson Cemetery:** Jonita and Ann Noble went and visited these sites last weekend. Mack Cemetery really deteriorating, no fence. Parkinson graves are fenced in. Graves aren't marked, have rocks on gravesites. Mack Cemetery is on BLM, but have to go through private property to get to it. Don Schooley will ask the Cemetery Board if they want to fence it. Should we bring it to the attention of the BLM? Carmel and Jonita will contact the Rock Springs BLM and ask about it.
- 5. **Merna X-Over Pipeline:** This pipeline crosses the historic Lander Trail in the Deer Hills area of Middle Piney near the Wyoming Range. Chance for an interpretive sign. Dave suggested we identify ourselves as an Interested Party to the BLM. 30-day comment period open.

Meeting called to order at 3:05PM by President Clint Gilchrist

- Review minutes of September 28, 2021 regular meeting
 <u>MOTION</u> by Dave Vlcek to accept minutes as presented. 2nd by Don Schooley, Unanimous, motion passes.
- 2. Big Sandy Lodge National Register Nomination grant application Copy of draft grant application in the board packet. DeWitt made some comments about challenges dealing with the Forest Service for their operations. Feels past history should be an element of the nomination. He supports the nomination and will write a Letter of Support. Grant is for \$5,000. A lot of the background research has already been done. Carmel will send some information to Clint. We will need Letters of Support from the Morris' and Forest Service.
 - <u>MOTION</u> by Dave we move forward with the grant application. 2nd by Don Schooley. Unanimous, motion passes.
 - More discussion, we will see what bids we get in. This process will take 2 years, over two of our budget cycles. Our intent is to have some kind of a public presentation once process complete. Once is approved by state, could take another year for national ruling.
- 3. **Bondurant Dipping Vat:** Rebuild almost complete. Carmel and Clint went up and met with representatives from the Forest Service and Campbell family. Still some changes to do. We need to pay Johnny Petersheim for his work for the second half for project. We paid first half up front. This isn't being considered a restoration project, rather educational. A lot of the parts are not functional. Would cost a lot more to make everything functional. The interpretive signs will explain more to public. We approved a total of \$8500 on this project last June.
- 4. **Merna X-Over Pipeline:** Clint sent a letter to the BLM with CLG input. Thank you to Dave for crafting most of the letter. The BLM also got input from OCTA folks (Oregon-California Trails Association). We're hoping for some interpretive signage as mitigation.
- 5. **Big Piney/Marbleton Historic Buildings Survey:** The final report was submitted to SHPO. We would like to give copies of the site forms to the land owners. Carmel will work on getting copies to get to land owners. Possibility of making the BELCO area into a historic district. Historical note: Don Schooley commented his father built all the cabinets in those cabins. We want to do a public program on it sometime, in conjunction with Green River Valley Museum. Clint will talk with Clarica about it (GRVM Executive Director).
- 6. **Graves Mack & Parkinson Cemetery:** Carmel and Jonita went out and visited the graves. BLM sent an email saying some fencing was possible. Don Schooley talked with the Cemetery Board

and they said they don't want to deal with all the little rural cemeteries. BLM said they were interested in visiting and doing some protection. Jonita and Carmel will put some historical information together and send to them for a Site Form. Clint will ask the Museum Board if they are interested in putting up any markers there, however their board probably won't meet until March or April. Don will check on costs for flat brass plaques.

7. Project Updates

- a) **Lookouts Deadline, Monument, Prospect:** Bob Beiermann attempted to get up to Deadline, but was snowed in. Will try again November 7th. Dave tried to get up to Monument, but was uncomfortable with the narrow road. Better with a 4-wheeler or a dirt bike. Need US Forest Service to take the lead on restoring Monument LO.
- b) Olson Site micro floral, sign, surface survey: Dave hasn't done the site forms yet will have by our November meeting.
- c) Holden Hill Sam Drucker project: Dave talked with Mike Bees about doing additional work out there. Would like to include the wagon tar area. Lynn Harrell of Lincoln County Historical Society supports a nomination to the National Register. Lincoln County does not have a CLG. We will stay in touch with them.
- d) Pinedale Skeletons Micro wear (\$700), Isotopes (\$500), DNA (\$8,000): Dave finally got some price info: \$18,000 \$20,000 for DNA testing on all. Owner Julie Morrell supports the analysis work. Discussion maybe we just test one?
